Our Impact

How we help survivors of domestic abuse in our community during calendar year 2022



7,189 calls made to Emerge's 24-hour multilingual hotline



5,111 individuals experiencing domestic abuse who received Emerge services



1,780 people who received community-based services



15,194 emergency shelter bed nights provided to families



67 participants and their children who were able to create a new home for themselves

Outcomes

We are dedicated to educating our community about the dynamics of abuse and creating safety in Pima County.

95% of participants said they feel more self-sufficient.

96% of participants feel that their safety has improved

200,000+ community members received educational emails during Domestic Violence Awareness Month.

91% of participants report having increased their knowledge of community resources and services.
